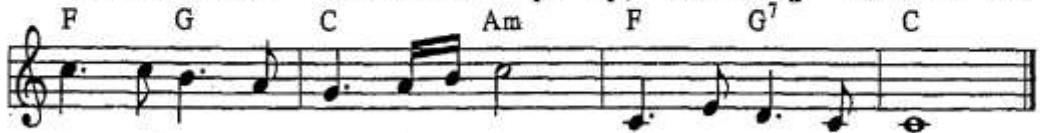

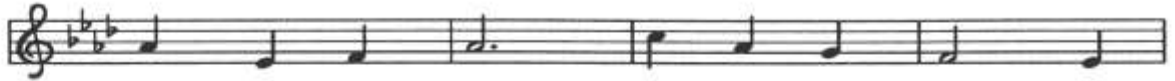

God' Works, Our Hands.

Every year ELCA sets aside one Sunday in September for God's Works where each congregation chooses a project or projects. For our 2022 God's Works Our Hands Sunday is set for September 11. There are three God's Works Our Hands projects that our church is doing for this year:

1. Suitcase and Duffel bags Drive

Did you know that most children in the foster care system have only a black trash bag to store their clothes and personal items as they move from place to place?

The Foster Care System in Louisville collects gently used suitcases and duffel bags to give to foster children to store their clothes and personal items. Suitcases and duffel bags must be clean, in good repair and have all zippers/fasteners in working order. Wheels on either are preferred but all good donations are appreciated. If you have any suitcases / **duffel bags you don't need, please consider donating them for these children. Bring your** items to church September 11th through the 18th. The items collected will be delivered to the collection site in late September.

2. Snack Packs for the Homeless

Working with Social Ministry Committee, we will host an event to assemble snack packs for the homeless on Sunday September 11th after 12 pm. Please consider staying for about 30 minutes to help as we assemble 200 packs. If you wish to donate funds to purchase items for the packs, please place your donation in an envelope marked "Snack Packs" and place in the offering plate.

3. Helping with the Aftermath Flood in Eastern Kentucky

There is a huge need for folks to come, even for the weekend, to help "muck and gut" homes before mold sets in.
