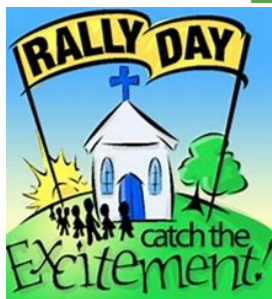

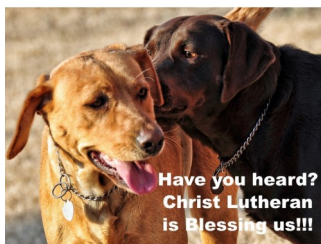

## **FAITHFUL SERVANT**

### **Kathleen Breitenstein**



For almost 30 years, Kathleen Breitenstein has been sharing her passions for music and education with the Christ Lutheran community. “My two anchors are singing and Sunday School.”

She and husband Dale joined CLC from First Lutheran, where they were involved in the Youth Group and where Kathleen’s mother had taught Sunday School

“forever.” At CLC, Kathleen started teaching an adult class, but soon noticed a gap in the Christian Education programming for students in middle and high school. While some people might be unsure about how to engage teenagers in religious discourse, Kathleen sees young adults differently. “That’s when I find them interesting, because they have a point of view.” Today, Kathleen heads up C.R.E.W. (Christians Ready, Enabled and Willing), where she and her co-teachers create a safe space for kids to talk about Christianity in ways that are relevant to their lives. She lights up when she talks about those moments of connection. “When that happens, it’s just the best gig ever. If they feel comfortable and safe and heard, not only do they have a good place to be, but they know there’s another adult who cares about them.”

When some of the high schoolers wanted to do an international trip, Kathleen got involved in supporting global mission work. The group teamed up with Hand in Hand Ministries to travel to Nicaragua and then Belize. She hopes they can work together again on local projects in Appalachia and the Portland area of Louisville, where Hand in Hand is headquartered. Kathleen has also journeyed to Nicaragua multiple times on her own to do cooking and sewing projects. Asked what it is about international mission work that speaks to her, Kathleen answers immediately. “You find out you have more similarities than differences. We love our families, we love our children, we love our God, we praise, we live, we eat.” With a smile, and wiping away a tear, she adds: “And it doesn’t have to be someone in a different country. It could be another part of town, or your neighbor across the street, or the person at the end of the pew.”



## **FAITHFUL SERVANT**

### **Hannah Limbong**

Hannah Limbong is starting her third year studying public health at UofL, following a summer internship with the Kentucky Cabinet of Health and Family Services in Frankfort. To those who know her, it's not too much of a surprise to learn that Hannah is looking for impactful, practical ways to serve. But that path is seldom easy, even for a pastor's daughter. "Being in college is hard," Hannah admits. "Sometimes I want to ask Jesus, 'why is this happening?' Instead, I try to ask Him, 'how can I see you in my life?'"



She looks to the little things — the liturgy, the prayers — to help renew and deepen her relationship with God every day. The Lord's Prayer, in particular, helps Hannah make what she calls the head-to-heart connection. "This is what Jesus taught his disciples to pray," she says, "and that's just cool." Hannah has long been interested in international affairs and learning about other cultures, dating back to her days in the Governor's Scholars Program. She also joined CLC's global mission trip to Belize in 2019 with fellow Faithful Servant Kathleen Breitenstein.

She especially credits the 2018 National Youth Gathering in Houston for changing the trajectory of her life. It was at that event that Hannah first heard about the Youth Leadership Summit. With help from Pastor Dan Fugate, Hannah traveled to Nebraska as one of two people representing Kentucky. From there, she applied to be part of the Youth Core Leadership Team (YCLT) and was the youngest member selected. For Hannah, these experiences add up to a lifetime journey that has its ups and downs. "I think that's what being faithful means to me — not knowing 100% where you'll end up, but trusting in God that it's a continuous process."

Hannah also admits she has a wiser perspective as a seasoned college junior. "I have the privilege of looking back now and making those head-to-heart connections. When you get where you're going, that's when it's evident we serve a God who is faithful."

## **Kicking Off the 2024-25 School Year**

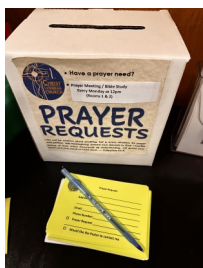
