Grace and peace to you my sisters and brothers in Christ,

When we were pregnant with our daughter Hannah, one of our members in Alaska gave us a book titled *What to Expect When You're Expecting* by Heidi Murkoff, Arlene Eisenberg, Sandee Hathaway, et al. That book basically spells out very much everything the new expected parents expect step by step during their pregnancy. It was very helpful for us as new parents.

I thought of using that as an analogy to inform you about what to expect as we are about to enter the Holy Week and Easter. Of course, it is good to keep in mind that not everything happens as expected. It is good to be open to expect the unexpected; let go and let God.

Believe it or not, we are very much at the end of our 40 days journey of Lent. Sunday April 6 will be the last Sunday in Lent. The following Sunday, April 13, is Palm Sunday and marks the beginning of our Holy Week. That day we celebrate Jesus' triumphal entry to Jerusalem when people welcomed him and shouted, "Hosanna, blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord." Sometimes that Sunday is called 'the Sunday of the Passion'. It is a conflated Sunday where celebration and passion are mixed together. Traditionally, here in our church, our services focus on the celebration of Jesus' triumphal entry to Jerusalem. The services begin with the blessing of the palms and the procession itself when we sing our familiar processional hymn 'All Glory, Loud and Honor!'

Bimen Limbong Director of Music - Ann Colbert Wade Church Office: 502-267-5082 Then within the Holy Week, we will enter the holiest time called 'Easter/ Paschal Triduum' (the three days of Easter) that begins with Holy (Maundy) Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday (Easter Vigil).

On Maundy Thursday we remember Jesus' Last Supper with his disciples, where Jesus washed the feet of his disciples and gave them a 'mandate' to wash each other's feet. The service closes with the stripping of the altar that reminds us that our Lord Jesus stripped to the waist to wash his disciples' feet – and how He was stripped and beaten before his crucifixion.

Good Friday is the most solemn of all days in the Christian church. On Good Friday, we remember that on account of our sin the Lord was crucified and died, we give joyful thanks to God that all our sin and God's wrath over sin falls on Jesus and not on us, and that by his grace we receive the benefit of this most sacrificial act. We call it Good Friday, because indeed there is something good coming out of it, our forgiveness of sin and salvation.

Holy Saturday is a day between Good Friday and Easter. Holy Saturday encompasses our Lord's rest in the tomb and His descent to the dead. The descent to the dead is not, however, the depth of Christ's humiliation, but rather the demonstration of His complete victory over death. On this night, we experience again the heart of God's baptismal promise and the center of our faith; we are claimed and cleansed, renewed in the death and resurrection of Christ.

And of course, we anticipate a joyful Easter on Sunday morning, celebrating the resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. Jesus conquered death and for those who believe in Him will not perish but have eternal life. Please join me as we end our Lent journey and enter into the Holy Week and celebrate the joyful Easter. Indeed, "Christ is Risen! He is Risen Indeed, Alleluia!"
