Grace and peace to you my siblings in Christ,

Seven Sundays of Easter have passed. Fifty days after Jesus' resurrection we celebrate Pentecost. The number 50 has a significant meaning in the Bible. First, it signifies the Jubilee. Every 50th year, the Israelite were to declare a year of jubilee, a time of rest of the land, release for the slaves, and forgiveness of debts, symbolizing a complete return to the original order and a fresh start (Leviticus 25:11-12).

Secondly, it signifies the fifty days after Passover, or the Feast of Weeks to commemorate the giving of the Law on Mt. Sinai. As Christians, it signifies Pentecost, the fifty days after Jesus' resurrection when God outpoured his Holy Spirit upon those Continued on pg. 2

who gathered in Jerusalem. The presence of fire and heavy wind during Pentecost also signifies the presence of God on the Mount Sinai when Moses received the Ten Commandments. For us we celebrate Pentecost as God gifted his people with the Holy Spirit to continue the works of Christ in the world.

In Pentecost we learn that God poured his Holy Spirit upon all flesh: "and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams. Even upon my slaves, both men and women, in those days I will pour out my Spirit; and they shall prophesy." (Acts 2:17-18).

Pentecost also marked as the birth of the church, the church of all nations where their languages are no longer divided but united people from every corner of the world. The same Holy Spirit was poured upon us in our baptism 'the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of council and might, the Spirit of knowledge and the fear of the Lord, the Spirit of joy in God's presence now and forever' (ELW). The Spirit calls, gathers, enlightens and sends us into the world for the sake of the gospel.

The Sundays after Pentecost make up the longest portion of the church year. Sometimes this Season is called 'Green Season' signifying the growth of the church or the Ordinary season because indeed, God is at work even in our ordinary or mundane season of our lives. We are nourished by God's Word and Sacraments to grow and live out our baptismal promises in a means of grace.

Sisters and brothers, as we enter this Pentecost or Green season, I invite you to focus on your Spiritual growth by participating in our worship, Bible Study, prayer and other ministry opportunities in our church. Our involvements in the life and ministry of the church and services will help boost our spiritual growth.

OUR PROPERTY IS POPPIN'!!!

The property committee and Wednesday Friends have been busy lately! Before the big rain we had, Dale replaced the old sump pump in the Brick House with a new one. That was quite timely! Then on Easter Sunday, Dale learned that the hot water in the kitchen was not working like it should. After much work, he replaced the expansion tank and did some other work, and was able to get it working again.

Raymond and Marilyn Peak each received a Thrivent grant, and put them to good use: one for playground mulch, and the other for flowers and shrubs around the building. Outside the gym doors you may notice the Candy Corn Spirea. The corner by the choir room has purple Angelonia, and the front entrance on Taylorsville road has lantana growing, as does the back garden. The playground has had eight pickup loads of new mulch added it.


The carpet in the building has been cleaned (\$1250) by All Quality Services early in May and the kitchen tile floor was steam cleaned/rinsed and the tile and grout was sealed with Fluoro chemical protector, which protects against spills, stains, dirt and grime (\$1225).

The historic sign that was in front of our church, until someone drove through it knocking it down, has been welded back together and will be replaced soon.

The Jeffersontown Fire Marshall did his "annual" inspection, and said our church needed to have motion sensors on the Sonitrol doors and we needed to have our fire alarm system inspected. Koorsen was brought in for the fire alarm inspection for \$998, and Sonitrol has added motion detectors to the two doors for \$900! We also check the exit signs and emergency lights in the building monthly to be sure they are working properly, as required by the fire marshal.

The lawn is being mowed by Rod Hester, with help from Dale Breitenstein or Raymond Peak, if needed. Dale continues to mow the cemetery. Wednesday Friends continue to weed around the grounds, and trim bushes, and pick up trash.

And please know <u>anyone is welcome to come help</u> for as long as you like. We usually start about 9:30 and work until 11:30 or whenever we feel like quitting!
