Psalm 122 by the way is part of the Song of Ascents (120-134) recited or sung by ancient Israelite pilgrims as they journey toward Jerusalem for the religious ceremonies or festivals. They are called the Songs of Ascents because the ancient pilgrims sang those songs as they ascended or climbed the hills to Jerusalem. They signify not just their physical journey but also their spiritual elevation as they entered the city of God or Zion with a great expectation to be in the presence of God in his temple. I like the opening line, "I rejoiced with those who said to me, 'Let us go to the house of the Lord'". It sets the tone for this brief yet profound meditation on joy, worship, community, and the peace that flows from belonging to God's people.

Like the pilgrims who rejoiced when those who said to them, 'let us go to the house of the Lord', let us also rejoice with the invitation of our church to come to the house of the Lord and see what God is doing. Let us also be the ones who invite our family, our children, grandchildren, friends and neighbors to come to the house of the Lord. Let us be intentional in our invitation.

Once again, our Rally Sunday reminds us of our common purpose and mission that God has given us, "Walking Together with Christ, We Love and Serve Our Church and Neighbor" and to fulfill our vision of being 'Connected with God, with One Another and The World'. We do so by rallying around the baptismal font where God claims us as his beloved children and send us into the world for the sake of the gospel, rallying around the pulpit where we hear God's Words, the good news of the Gospel to nourish our faith and rallying around the altar, where Jesus feeds us with his body and blood and to be the body of Christ in the world. So, welcome! Join us in our rally for Christ and his church.

Honoring Audrey Albin's Legacy of Generosity

Through her bequest to Christ Lutheran Church, longtime member Audrey Albin left a lasting gift that reflects both her lifelong commitment to her faith community and her enduring generosity. This thoughtful act not only honors her memory but will help strengthen the church she cherished for generations to come.



Audrey and husband Earl, who preceded her in death, met in a one-room schoolhouse in New Middletown, Indiana. They moved to Louisville in 1952 when Earl started working in the home laundry department at GE. Soon they joined Christ Lutheran when it was still the little church on Waterson Trail in Jeffersontown. When Earl passed away in 2016, they had been married just shy of 75 years.

Both were deeply involved in church life. Earl helped with maintenance projects, and Audrey served with the women's group. Both also tended the church landscaping, a tradition their daughter, Pat Friedman, continues with the Wednesday Friends.

"They were great examples for me, really fine role models," Pat says. "They believed you should do as much as you can for as many as you can for as long as you can."

Audrey passed away on September 26, 2024, survived by Pat — herself a lifetime member at Christ Lutheran — and sons David and Gary, who live in Georgia and New Albany. With her final gift, Audrey continues to serve the church that meant so much to her.

We hope we see all of our amazing kids on this very special day.



your favorite gospel songs?



I was invited to be the young adult representative and Petra was invited to be the young adult representatives for the



Indiana-Kentucky Synod at the 2025 Churchwide Assembly in Phoenix, Arizona. I received a phone call when I was in Malawi to see if I would be available to serve in this

capacity. It was an unexpected honor but I couldn't help but wonder why God made a way for me to be there.

While this wasn't my first Churchwide, I came in with a new lens and a deeper understanding of the life and work of the greater Church. If you've ever been to synod assembly or our annual CLC meetings, I like to think of the Churchwide Assembly as that but on some serious steroids. We discussed and voted on topics ranging from the budget to social statements. It was incredible to be a part of historical moments such as voting for our new Presiding Bishop, Rev. Yehiel Curry and our new Secretary, Rev. Lucille "CeCee" Mills.

There was one particular moment that stood out to me. One of my peers submitted a constitutional amendment to change the goal of the ELCA to have higher youth and young adult representation on Churchwide boards and committees. I had the opportunity to be one of the first people to speak on the amendment. I shared about how youth and young adult leadership has been



meaningful in my own life. I was touched watching my peers stand up and feeling moved to share their story. The lines to speak at the microphones spoke louder than words—the younger generation cares. We love Jesus and care about the Church and the World

1 Timothy 4:12 "Let no one despise your youth, but set the believers an example in speech and conduct, in love, in faith, in purity".


